1. Purpose:

2. Definition

Sustainable Procurement, also sometimes referred to as 'Responsible Sourcing', is considering social, ethical and environmental principles in procurement processes and decisions, alongside other stakeholder requirements.

3. Scope

It applies to all sourcing and procurement activities within the Company, starting with assessing the need of a purchase, and ending with collaborative supplier improvements and innovation.

- Reducing the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions and carbon footprint during the project execution
